The Tiptree World Bread Awards, launched in January 2013, seek to celebrate the very best of British bread baking. Entries have more than doubled since then. With 12 million loaves sold in the UK every day, it is an industry whose greatest exponents deserve to be celebrated. "The choice, range and quality of bread in Britain today is immense," says **Caroline Kenyon**, Director of the Awards.
